

Will the OA Team pay my APC from the block grants? Yes, if the following conditions apply:

Your paper acknowledges research funding from a block grant provider

- The University receives block grants from British Heart Foundation (BHF), Cancer Research UK (CRUK), UKRI/RCUK (AHRC, BBSRC, ESRC, EPSRC, MRC, NERC, STFC. Research England and Innovate UK may be eligible; more information is available in [Annex 1](#) of the UKRI policy); and Wellcome Trust.

There is no compliant green route that can be used as an alternative

- The University's [Self-Archiving Policy](#) will provide a compliant green route where publishing gold open access is optional (e.g. in hybrid or transformative journals).

The corresponding author is affiliated with the University of Cambridge

Your funder will pay APCs for your paper type
